Membership Fees

Throughout the school year the Newfoundland and Labrador Athletics Association hosts and sanctions numerous cross country, track and field and road running events. To compete at these events each participant must be a registered member of the NLAA. To promote our sport at the school level and to make it more accessible to students the NLAA conducts some of its events **for schools exclusively and school grades are used to determine the age categories**. We allow for students and schools to participate at these events by registering with the NLAA at a nominal membership fee. These fees are as follow:

School: During the school year, schools may join the NLAA as associate clubs for \$20.00. At this point, school athletes may compete in NLAA sanctioned events which are **organized for schools exclusively and school grades are used to determine the age categories**. All school athletes will then be considered NLAA members for the duration of the school year, competing under their school name in NLAA sanctioned events (no One Day Registration fees apply).

Individual: One Day Registration in NLAA for Primary and Secondary School Athletes during the school year is \$1.00. (Applicable to non-school members only.) To be eligible for the reduced fee a student must participate at events that are organized exclusively for schools and school grades are used to determine the age categories.

Competing at regular NLAA sanctioned events would require an individual athlete to upgrade to a full NLAA membership or pay One Day Registration of \$5.00

Membership Benefits

Membership/Affiliation in the NLAA allows an athlete to compete in our sanctioned events. Every sport organization pays insurance as a corporate body on behalf of event organizers and athletes in case of legal liability or mishaps. Sanction fees and membership fees help to cover these costs and ensure that people will be willing to volunteer their time.

There are opportunities to benefit from courses and clinics -- as an athlete, official, or a coach. The NLAA also supervises events in order to ensure that rules are followed and criteria maintained on as even a basis throughout the province as possible. The NLAA also supervises Provincial Events, and also Road Running, Track and Field, and Cross-Country Championships.
